“God’s Love is Wider than You Think”

Background:

- The Jews were God’s chosen people.
- Israel was chosen to be a blessing and to show God’s glory to the world.
- Over time, the Jews made their “chosen-ness” a point of prejudice and pride.
- The first Christians were almost all converted Jews.
- People who failed to observe Jewish customs were considered unclean.
- The first Christians assumed that if you wanted to be a Christian, you had to become a Jew first.

What you need to know about God’s love:

1. God’s love has NO LIMITS.
2. God’s love is UNCONDITIONAL - includes everyone, everywhere, at all times.

3. God's love demolishes RACISM, CLASSICISM, SNOBBERY, and PREJUDICE.

4. God's love compels him to RESPOND to SINCERE SEEKERS.

5. God's love is demonstrated in the GOSPEL - the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus.
