Three chairs at the Lord's Table:

Chair #1 – In the _____, and in the _____ (JOHN)

- was Jesus' best friend
- sat close to Jesus at the Last Supper (John 13:23-25)
- was called "the disciple that Jesus loved"

Chair #2 – In the FAMILY, but not in the FELLOWSHIP (_____)

- his heart was with Jesus
- had trouble being faithful

Luke 22:33-34

- failed BIG TIME
- was ultimately restored

Chair #3 – Not in the FAMILY, not in the FELLOWSHIP (_____)

- sat at the table with everybody else
- with Jesus at the table, but not with Jesus in his heart
- he did not, would not, believe in Jesus
- died in despair, a pathetic, broken man

The Table represents _____.

- All three men were at The Table.
- Jesus offered the bread and the cup to all three.
- Jesus died on the cross for all three.
- All three had opportunity to believe in Jesus.

The Table represents a _____.

- Every person has to decide for themselves what they are going to do about Jesus.
- The broken body and the blood of Jesus invite us all to turn from our sins, believe in Jesus, and receive forgiveness and a new way of life.
